Aims

This policy includes the measures we are taking to reduce the risk of transmission of Coronavirus in our setting. All persons in the setting are kindly requested to follow all these rules diligently to sustain a healthy and safe setting and to keep the risk of transmission as low as possible. This policy is subject to change with no notice given with the introduction of additional or changed government guidelines. If this happens we will notify parents as soon as possible.

Procedures

- All parents will be given a copy of our Coronavirus guidelines and will be asked to return a signed copy which will confirm their agreement to our temporary change in practice.
- No child will be accepted into the setting without this being returned.
- A risk assessment has been completed and can be found in the risk assessment folder.
- Our guidelines are subject to change without notice in line with government advice.
- Preschool have the right to refuse to accept anyone into the setting who has been asked to test for Coronavirus and cannot provide proof of a negative result.
- Our guide to parents outline the required actions of staff, parents and children who wish to access our setting during these exceptional circumstances.
- Windows within the setting will be left open when possible to allow for good ventilation.
